From the website or admissions office.

Yes, for applicable courses.

Yes.

18. What examination body is used?

CDACC and other approved bodies where applicable.

19. Can I transfer courses?

Yes, subject to approval.

20. How do I contact the college?

Use the contacts on the official website.

21. Are scholarships available?

Some opportunities may be available.

22. What documents are required during admission?

Academic certificates, ID/Birth Certificate and passport photos.

Yes.

24. Are short courses offered?

Yes, depending on demand.
